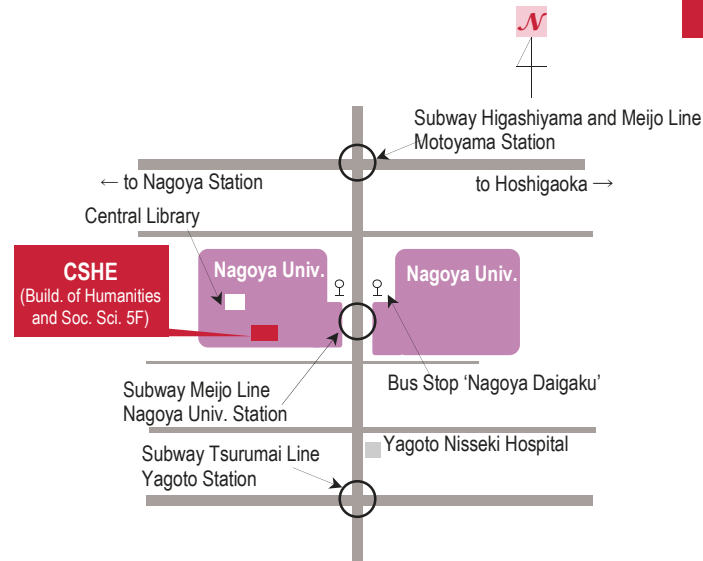

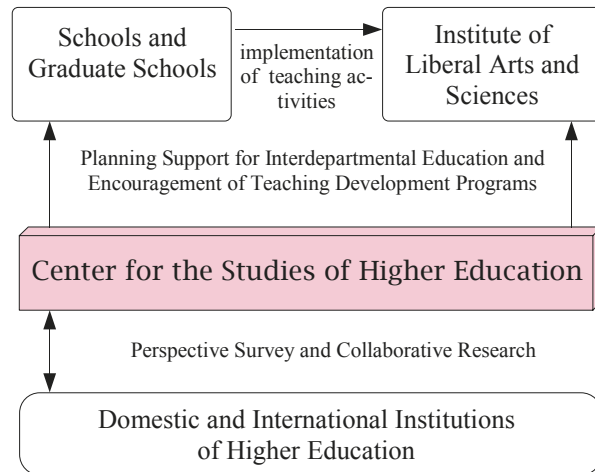

CONTRIBUTION TO NU

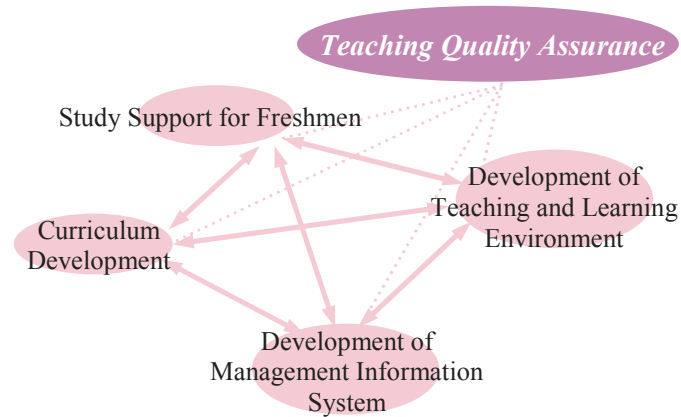
The mission of the Center is to make scholarly contributions with international perspectives on strategic issues in higher education.
